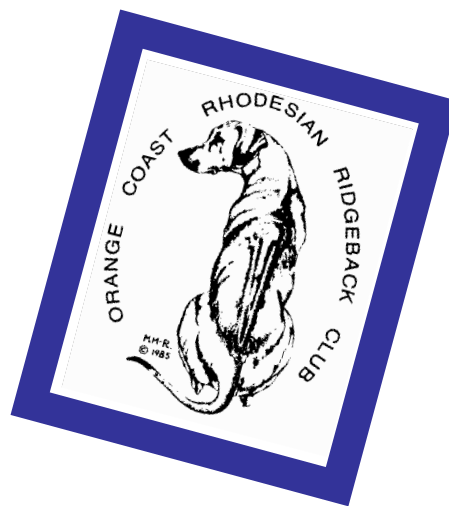

## AKC Canine Good Citizen Testing

Sunday, February 19, 2012,  
after Obedience & Rally Judging



The AKC Canine Good Citizen (CGC) program promotes responsible dog ownership by recognizing well-mannered dogs. The CGC test consists of a dog and handler team performing the following simple tasks for an evaluator: accepting a friendly stranger; sitting politely for petting; allowing basic grooming; walking on a loose lead; walking through a crowd; sitting and lying down on command and staying in place; coming when called; reacting appropriately to another dog; reacting appropriately to distractions; and calmly enduring a short supervised separation from owner. Dogs who satisfactorily complete all tasks earn the CGC title, which can be proudly displayed after the dog's name: for example, "CH Fido, CGC".

*California has joined the growing list of states that have passed resolutions endorsing the AKC CGC Test* for the extremely positive impact it has had in many communities, and for the outstanding contributions it has made in advocating responsible dog ownership.

### **Please take advantage of this special opportunity to earn the CGC title.**

Owners must supply current rabies certificate, grooming tool, 5-6ft. walking leash and collar (belt or choke type only). Test fee is \$10, plus additional \$5 fee payable to AKC for the CGC certificate. CGC bandanas will be available for \$5. *All dogs are welcome, whether purebred or mixed!* NO bitches in season allowed.

**CGC entries will be taken on the day of the event.**



### **FOOD FOR THOUGHT...**

Every person earning a CGC title on their Ridgeback is actively aiding the battle against those groups whose goal is to make it more difficult, or even impossible, for us to enjoy the companionship of our dogs by enacting breed-specific legislation or breeding bans.

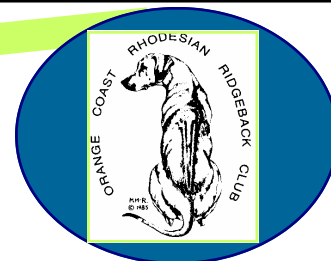

## WE WANT TO SEE YOUR DOG IN THE PROPERTY CLASS COMPETITIONS!

### Best Male Head

It doesn't matter how many crowns he has, if he appears swayback, or whether or not he has three legs! Does he have a beautiful MALE head? That's all that's going to be looked at in this class.

### Best Female Head

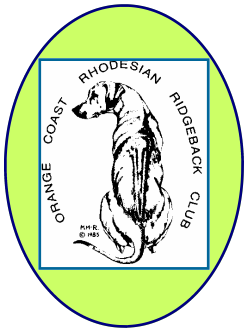
It doesn't matter how many crowns she has, if she appears swayback, or whether or not she has three legs! Does she have a beautiful FEMALE head? That's all that's going to be looked at in this class.

### Best Movement

(Both sexes will be judged together): Do NOT enter your three-legged dog in this category! Dogs will be judged on their "gait."

### Best Ridge

(Both sexes will be judged together): Do NOT enter a dog who has multiple or (extremely) offset crowns, one who doesn't have enough crowns, or one with a too-short ridge.
