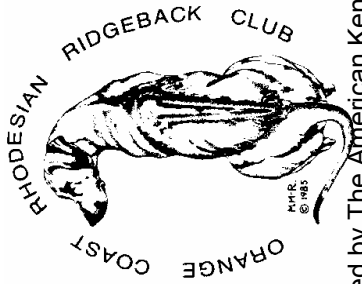

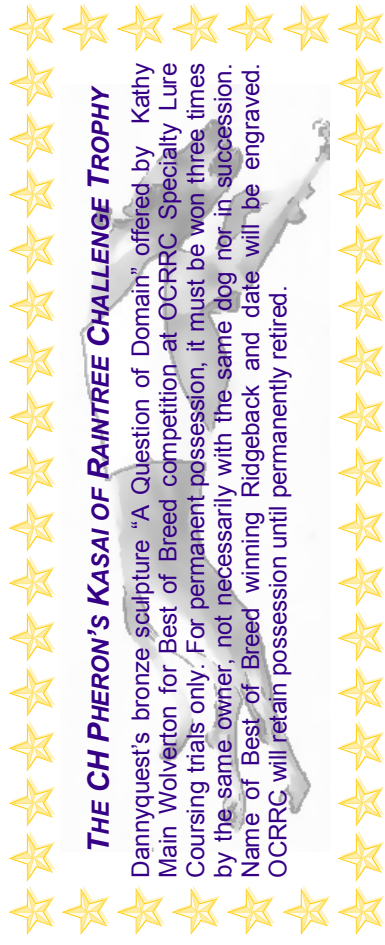

ELIGIBLE BREEDS & REGISTRY

Only purebred Rhodesian Ridgebacks that are one year of age or older and have been registered with the American Kennel Club or an AKC recognized foreign registry or that have been granted an Indefinite Listing Privilege (ILP) may be entered.

Spayed or neutered hounds are eligible to compete; Monorchid or Cryptorchid are not eligible. Hounds with breed disqualifications as listed in the AKC Breed Standard are ineligible to enter lure coursing trials and tests. Substitutions are allowed for lame or injured hounds only if the substitute has the same owner and notification is given at least 1/2 hour prior to Check-In.

DIRECTIONS

From Oak Canyon Park Show Site: Turn right on Santiago Canyon Road and proceed to CA-241 North (portions toll). Merge onto CA-91 East toward Riverside. Merge onto the 71 North. Take the Butterfield Ranch Road/Euclid Avenue (CA-83) exit. Turn right. The facility is on the right side 1/10 of a mile down Euclid Ave.

From San Gabriel Valley: Take the 210 East to the 57 South. Then, transition on the 71 South towards Corona. Take the Butterfield Ranch Road/Euclid Avenue (CA-83) exit and turn left. The facility will be located on the right side 1/3 of a mile down Euclid Avenue.

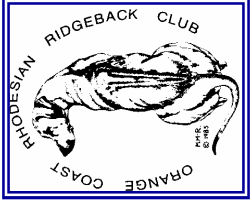
From Inland Empire: Take the 91 West onto the 71 North. Exit Butterfield Ranch Road/Euclid Avenue (CA-83) and make a right. The facility will be located on the right side 1/10 of a mile down Euclid Avenue.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Bitches in season, lame hounds and hounds with breed disqualifications will be excused at roll call and their entry fees will be refunded. Bitches in season must be removed from the grounds.
2. Hounds will be examined for breed disqualifications – spayed & neutered hounds may be entered.
3. There will be a \$5,000 fine assessed for any loose hound not taking part in course in progress. OCRRC will strictly enforce this assessment.
4. All hounds will run twice, in trios if possible, or braces unless excused, dismissed or disqualified. Course will be reversed for finals and run-offs and Best of Breed run.
5. Hounds not present at the time of Roll Call will be scratched after 5-minute grace period.
6. Equipment will be battery powered continuous loop lure machines. The lure will consist of white plastic strips. Back-up equipment will be available.
7. The Field Committee reserves the right to bar aggressive dogs from the event site.
8. Incomplete, unsigned, conditional or unpaid entries will not be accepted. No fax or on-line entries will be accepted. Entries will be acknowledged by email.
9. Muzzles are not required, but are permitted at the handler's discretion.
10. Stakes shall be split each time the entry is sufficient to hold 2 or more 5-point majors.
11. No entry fees will be refunded if the Trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes, or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Field Committee.
12. The Club, Field Committee, their agents, employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, theft, damage, injuries or death sustained by exhibitors or handlers to any dog or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children while at or on the Trial grounds, or in transit to/from the Trial grounds.
13. Dogs must be ready for judging. Judges need not wait for dogs holding up a stake.
14. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified or dismissed by a judge, barred from competition by action of the Field Committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to a check being returned. The returned check must be made good by cash or money order before the dog will be entered correctly. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.
15. The Club and/or Trial Secretary assume no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry form by the owner or agent of the owner. The Club and/or the Trial Secretary assume no responsibility for the owner or owner's agent for entering a dog in a stake in which the dog is not eligible to compete.
16. Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or by electronic mail prior to the close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.
17. If hounds owned or co-owned by the same person are not to run together, the owner must state this on the entry form.
18. A park restroom will be available at the venue.
19. All trophies and prizes must be claimed the day of the Trial; none will be mailed. OCRRC reserves the right to substitute a trophy or prize of equal or greater value.
20. Anyone exhibiting unsportsmanlike conduct will be excused from the field for the day.
21. No one, except Field Committee members, will be allowed on the field without the express permission of the Field Chairman.



LURE COURSING TRIAL (new rules effective 1/1/10)

OPEN STAKE: Open to hounds that have obtained an AKC Qualified Course Certificate, an ASFA Field Champion Title, or a CKC Field Champion Title. Hounds that have earned an AKC Field Champion Title are not eligible to enter the Open Stake. *It is also recommended that every Qualifying Hound has been run previously alone and that to the handler's satisfaction runs cleanly and keenly.*

SPECIAL STAKE: Open to hounds that have earned their AKC Field Champion Title.

OPEN VETERAN STAKE: Open to hounds that are eligible to enter the Open or Special Stakes and have reached 6 years of age on the day of the trial, except Irish Wolfhounds at 5 years of age, Rhodesian Ridgebacks at 7 years of age, and Whippets at 7 years of age.
